

Privacy statement on the protection of personal data in relation to the user consultation process within the ENTRUSTED project

All personal data are dealt with in compliance with the applicable rules on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data (currently Regulation (EU) 2018/1725).

The following data protection information notice outlines the criteria by which the ENTRUSTED Consortium members under the Grant Agreement No. 870330 and the external collaborators to the project will collect, manage and use personal data in relation to the user consultation process carried out within the ENTRUSTED project (also referred to as “the Survey”).

Purposes of data processing:

1. To manage the provided information in the answers to the questionnaires.
2. To process the submitted request for information related to the user consultation process through the ENTRUSTED website.
3. To communicate important information related to the user consultation process.
4. To process data for statistical and management purposes.

Data/Categories of data concerned:

Data collected through the Survey questionnaires:

We request, from the reference person providing the survey answers, the following data:

- Name and last name
- Job function within the entity
- Email
- Name of the entity represented

Data collected during the request for information through the website:

The following personal data is requested, in order to be able to answer their enquiries and put them in contact with the appropriate Point of Contact (PoC) for the survey, via a dedicated online registration form:

- Mandatory data: entity name, country in which the entity is registered, e-mail address;
- Non-mandatory fields: name, surname, occupational category.

Recipients/Categories of recipients of the data processed:

Access to personal data is granted on a 'need to know' basis to:

1. Data processors: ENTRUSTED Consortium members and the external collaborators to ENTRUSTED, who are also Member States representatives or EU entities, which are bound by personal data protection rules equal to those applying to the GSA;
2. Staff of the European Commission, and the GOVSATCOM Expert Group managed by them;
3. Staff of the Research Executive Agency (REA), as Contracting Authority in the frame of the Grant Agreement No. 870330, may also access personal data, in their quality of managing and monitoring the aforementioned Grant Agreement.

Any recipient of personal data will be reminded of its obligation not to use the data received for other purposes than the one for which they were transmitted.

Legal basis/Lawfulness of the processing:

Processing of personal data is based on the consent of the data subject, in compliance with Art. 5(1)(d) of Regulation 2018/1725, whereby data subject has unambiguously given his or her consent to provide personal data by filling-in and submitting the online registration form with the requested personal data.

Information on the storage locations and retention period of personal data:

1. Personal data will be stored electronically on the servers of the ENTRUSTED project members, including cloud hosting servers, which are located in the EU.
2. Personal data will be retained for 7 years after the expiry of the Grant Agreement No. 870330 for audit and discharge purposes. Once the retention period is over, personal data will be destroyed.

Automated decision-making

Your personal data will not be used for automated decision-making, including profiling.

Participants in the ENTRUSTED user consultation process, either being contacted by ENTRUSTED partners or having registered via the online form (i.e. data subjects) have the right:

1. To obtain confirmation as to whether or not his or her personal data are being processed, access the data and obtain detailed information on the processing;
2. Of rectification of inaccurate personal data;
3. Of erasure of personal data if the statutory provisions are met;
4. Of restriction of processing if the statutory provisions are met;
5. To data portability, allowing to obtain and reuse personal data for their own purposes across different services;
6. To withdraw the consent to personal data processing at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing before the consent's withdrawal;
7. To lodge a complaint to the European Data Protection Supervisor at EDPS@edps.europa.eu should they consider that the processing operations do not comply with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725.
